If official polo shirt is not worn must wear plain navy polo shirt

If official shorts are not worn must wear plain navy shorts

If official skirt is not worn must wear plain navy skirt

If official jacket is not worn must wear a plain navy jacket or jumper

If official tracksuit pants are not worn must wear plain navy tracksuit pants

If official hat is not worn students may provide their own preferably navy in colour and a bucket hat style

Hair: Students with hair longer than shoulder length will be required to tie their hair up

Shoes: Students are encouraged to wear shoes that are appropriate for physical activity and provide adequate support and protection

Make-up: Students are encouraged not to wear make-up and nail polish to school

Jewellery: Students are encouraged not to wear jewellery to school however there will be allowances for observation of religious and cultural beliefs
