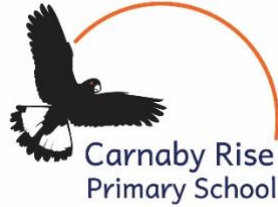


# CARNABY RISE VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

## How to enhance the quality of the teaching and learning program at Carnaby Rise Primary School



### WHAT ARE CHARGES?

These are costs that **MAY** arise through-out the year which will not exceed the amount on the attached table. Some of the activities are specific to certain year groups. Families will be provided advanced notice of the required cost and can organise for a payment plan if required

**You will only be charged for costs that are relevant to your child**

### WHEN WILL I BE CHARGED?

Activities that require students to travel outside of the school for learning experiences or a specific in-school activity. This could include but not limited to excursions and incursions, swimming lessons, school photos and other extra-curricular activities.

### WHAT ARE VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS?

This is a **\$60** amount paid voluntarily for each student. It assists the school to purchase resources and materials that enhance the learning experience for students.

### HOW DOES THE \$60 BENEFIT MY FAMILY?

For Kindy and Pre-Primary students, it assists to provide more variety in dress-ups, painting, puzzles, books and games and equipment in the playground

For Year 1-6 students it contributes to better equipment in learning areas such as Phys Ed, Art and Science, greater variety in books in the library and for use in classrooms during literacy

### WHAT IS THE ICT VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION?

This is a **\$25** amount paid voluntarily by Kindy students and a **\$50** amount paid voluntarily by each PP – Year 6 student. It assists the school to purchase ICT equipment and resources that enhance the learning experience for students.

### HOW DOES THE \$60 BENEFIT MY FAMILY?

This assists the school to purchase iPads, Macbooks, and STEM resources such as Beebots, Sphero, Makey Makey and Lego Spike.

It also saves your family money as there is no need to provide a device for your child to use at school.

The saving while your child is at primary school is approximately **\$3500**

### HOW DO I PAY CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES?

Both can be paid using the Qkr! App or by EFTPOS at the front office

Voluntary Contributions can also be paid when purchasing booklist items from Campion

If paying in one lump sum is difficult, a payment plan can be organised. Please see the ladies in the front office who will discuss the different options that suit your circumstance
